- He announced that we now have one P&L statement, with the correct month by month P&L with year-end totals so that we can compare 2018 to 2019. This will allow us to create a budget for the first time ever!
- Group contributions for Dec18 are also included in tonight's handouts.

OFFICE REPORT: Lincoln

- Lincoln had a report that someone tried to attend a group last week and the group was locked and no one was there. If you are new to Intergroup please send an email to office@aadallas.org with your name, group name, email address, and phone number. This will help us identify groups that have been disbanded or whose schedules have changed.
- Inventory last month more fun and went well and done in one day. Closed out the year in a great way, migration to new systems is complete.
- The problems that we expect to see now will be day-to-day such as checks not indicating whether they are for contributions or payments for literature. If we do not know which, we always mark as a contribution.
- Our Intergroup Inventory is built back up and we are now only replacing what we are selling. We are financially stable we can buy what we need.
- Volunteer requirements have changed: all service commitments (published) require 1 year sober, that you have a sponsor, and are working the steps. Step Speakers have a five year minimum sobriety requirement.
- 12-step call list is being updated. We really need people from south of I30 people. Spread the word if you are willing to take calls, 1 year requirements, etc.
- Our Intergroup Inventory found some Braille literature. We shared with the Reference Librarian at Oak Lawn Library who also asked for English and Spanish Literature. We also have some 12x12 and Daily Reflections but no more Big Books.
- We are donating storage shelves or display cases
- Printing new directories every few months if you know anyone who does PHP programming, this will help us create these new directories in the format that GSO uses. Contact Lincoln for more info.
- Building management has spoken to the therapist next door about moving and even offered 2 months free rent, but she has not taken them up on it yet
