**HISTORY OF THE CONFERENCE::** IN 1965, BERNADETTE O'K AND OTHER AA WOMEN IN KANSAS CITY HELD A CONFERENCE JUST FOR WOMEN IN AA.

The conference became known as the National AA Women's Conference.

This forum aimed to provide:

- Sharing of experiences common to women alcoholics
- Discussion of problems of particular interest to all women AA members.
- Opportunities to hear AA women speakers from many areas.

Forty-five members attended the first conference in Kansas City. The reception was so enthusiastic that plans were laid to create an annual women's AA conference.
