## TREASURER'S REPORT: Leigh I.

- January showed a loss of \$2,247. In part, because Dave extended his departure to assist Kathy therefore the increase in payroll. Merchandise Sales dropped 47% year-to-year and Contributions were down 12% year-to-year.
- The Board has suggested changes in the budget to reflect the extraordinary environment. The change will reflect projected Merchandise sales for 2021 of the following January through April of \$10,000 per month, May through August at \$12,500 per month and September through December at \$15,000 per month, the originally projected amount.
- Tom M. detailed the Intergroup's financial position as very stable despite the losses.
   Sufficient operating funds are available with Total Checking and Savings of \$47,590 and Total Prudent Reserves of \$16,615
