Treasurer Report Ian:

1. Donations were just under budget, but Merch Sales (and respective COGS) were higher than expected.
2. Inventory shrinkage was \$634.
3. Paul's Wages were around \$700 higher than expected due to Sam's paternity leave.
4. Property tax we budgeted \$681 for in January was paid back in October.
5. Sam was reimbursed for mileage for all of 2025 in January (\$292). Going forward, this will be reimbursed quarterly to reduce the burden on the month it is reimbursed.
6. With these items, the overall net loss for January was -\$202, which is \$1,037 lower than the budget.

- Raised prices to match AAWS.
