Treasurer Report Ian:

Contributions up \$1,253.07 total over budget.

Sales \$843.05 over budget, but costs \$715.35 over budget.

Net Revenue for May 2026 \$1,048.33 over budget.

Office Report Samuel:

- IGRs as 12 step coordinators or as “contact finders”
 - Responsible for coordinating 12th step calls? Or keep the same: IGR’s responsible for finding 2 men and 2 women from your group for Intergroup’s 12th step contact list.
 - Concept 12, Warranty Four: “That all important decisions be reached by discussion, vote, and whenever possible, by substantial unanimity.”
- Hybrid equipment budget: \$500
- Actual TOTAL spent: **\$345**
 - Chromebook \$209
 - Webcam \$26
 - Table \$25
 - Projector \$61
 - Laptop bag \$14
 - Cable: \$10
 - Zoom \$15/mo (not included in total)

- Report on Inventory Valuation
 - AAWS \$31,446
 - Grapevine \$2,430
 - DIA (NC Cards, Envelopes, brochures, etc) \$1,604
 - Medallions \$5,506
 - Non-Conference Approved \$1,426
 - **TOTAL: \$42,413**
 - **Aiming to have \$10k less cash tied up in inventory, to hover around \$32k on average.** Reducing Target Quantities of AAWS and Medallions.
 - AAWS Target: \$23,000 or less by end of year.
 - Medallions \$3,500 or less by end of year.
 - Inventory asset may rise temporarily if AAWS does a seasonal sale. We purchase larger quantities when books are cheaper.
